- 1) The responsible party will be billed for tuition, fees, and books for retaking a college class. No student allotment may be used.
- 2) Dropping a college course after the college drop deadline will result in the responsible party being billed for the tuition, fees, consumable books, and access codes.
- 3) Withdrawing from a college course during the college withdraw period will result in a grade of “W” on your high school and college transcripts. The “W” will stay even if student retakes the course.
- 4) Logos pays for required books listed on the college booklist only. Logos will not pay for optional books on the booklist nor additional materials, fees, or supplies (examples: PE fees, art materials, YMCA fees, driver’s ed) listed on the course syllabus. These additional costs will be paid by the responsible party.
